


English Year 3- The parts of a story mountain: Students wove a story about pirates bearing in mind the 5 key elements.

The school counsellor, Ms. Joyce spoke to the students about the pillar of Character Building.






Ms. Joyce, conducted a session on Friendship and Relationships and explained the concept through an activity.
