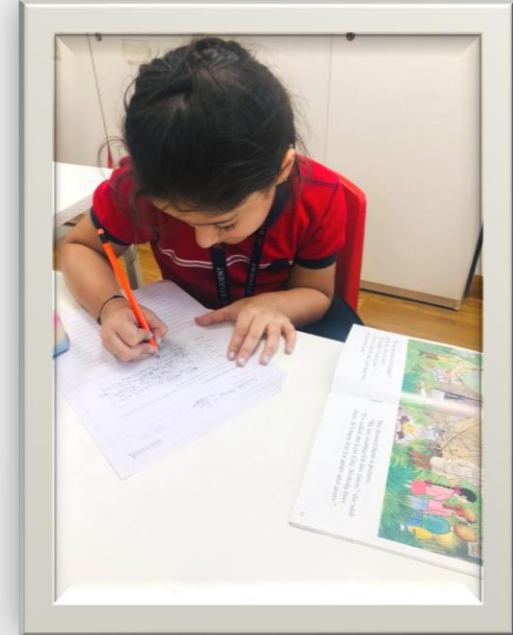
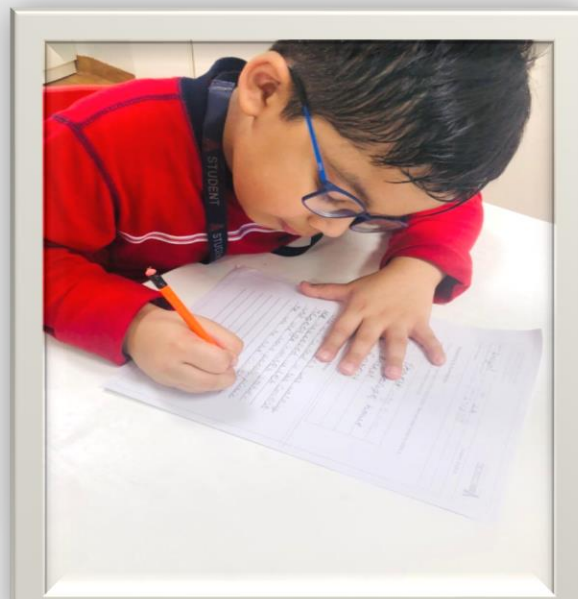
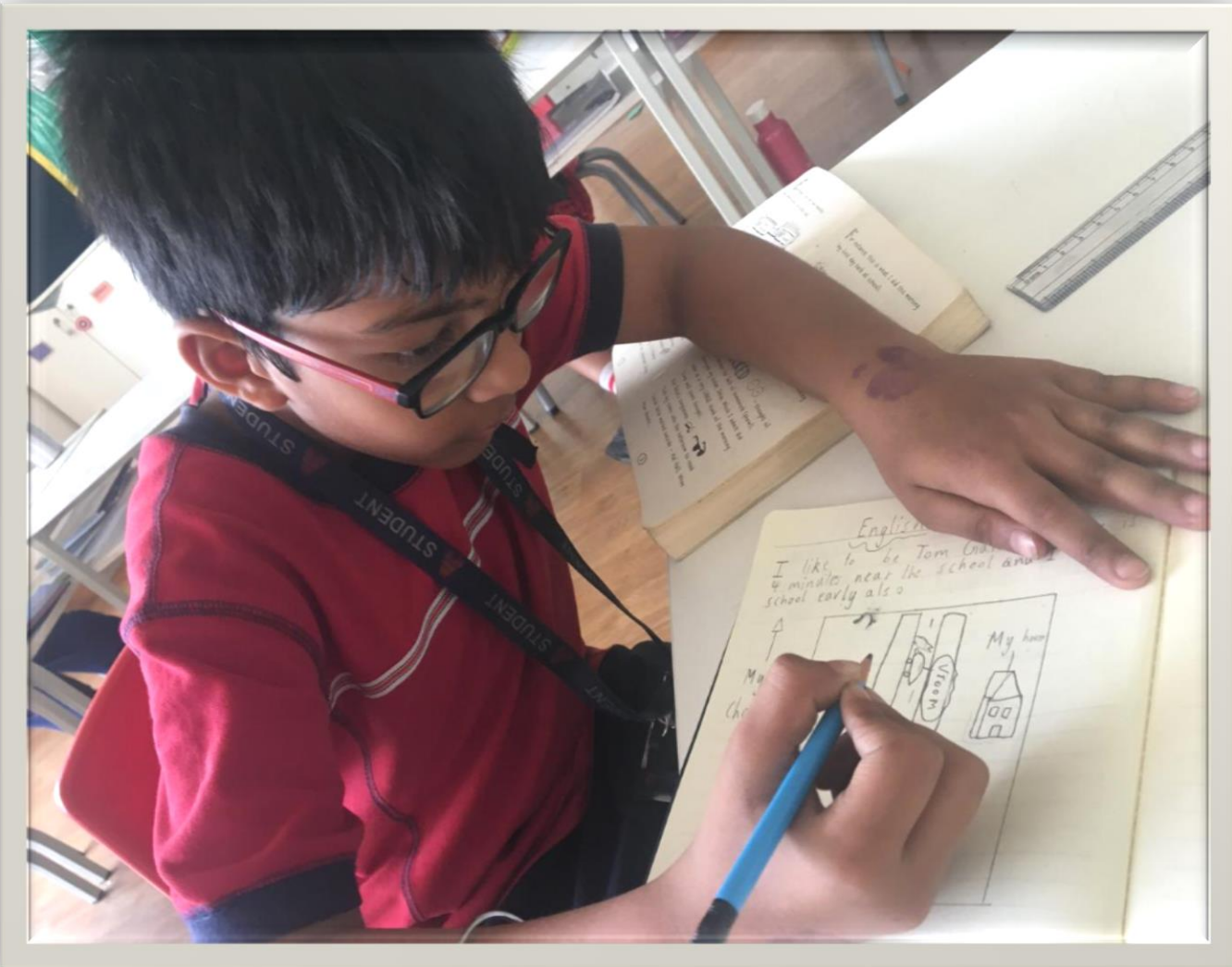
Reading period is our favourite period : The students eagerly look forward to their reading period where they do many activities. This month they did activities based on character feeling , setting etc,

The students were mesmerized by the printing press unit and the book production process and they also learnt interesting facts about the supply and demand of the books .
